A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the department in which the Coast Guard is operating to submit to the Congress a plan and cost estimate for the engineering, design, and retrofitting of the icebreaker MACKINAW.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PLAN FOR THE ENGINEERING, DESIGN, AND**
4 **RETROFITTING OF THE ICEBREAKER MACKI-**
5 **NAW.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than May 1, 1997, the
7 Secretary of the department in which the Coast Guard is

1 operating shall submit to the Committees a plan and cost
2 estimate for the engineering, design, and retrofitting of
3 the icebreaker MACKINAW (WAGB-83) to equip the ves-
4 sel with new engines, command and control features, hab-
5 itability improvements, and other features needed to allow
6 operation of the vessel by a significantly reduced crew, in-
7 cluding 24-hour continuous operation when necessary.

8 (b) COMMITTEES DEFINED.—In subsection (a), the
9 term “Committees” means the Committee on Transpor-
10 tation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives
11 and the Committee on Commerce of the Senate.

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
