## A BILL

To provide regulatory relief for certain farm transportation of hazardous materials.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Farm Transportation  
5 Regulatory Relief Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON REGULATION OF AGRICULTURAL**  
2 **PRODUCTION MATERIAL TRANSPORTATION.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Any regulation issued by the De-  
4 partment of Transportation relating to the transportation  
5 of agricultural production material as a hazardous mate-  
6 rial under chapter 51 of title 49, United States Code, shall  
7 not prohibit a State from providing an exception from the  
8 hazardous materials transportation regulations for farm-  
9 ers and retailers who are providing not-for-hire intrastate  
10 transportation of an agricultural production material from  
11 a source of supply to a farm, from a farm to another farm,  
12 from a field to another field on a farm, or from the farm  
13 back to the source of supply.

14 (b) **AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION MATERIAL DE-**  
15 **FINED.**—In this section, the term “agricultural production  
16 material” means a hazardous material that is used to sup-  
17 port the production of an agricultural commodity and in-  
18 cludes pesticides, fertilizers, and fuels.
