 - 5 (1) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-
 - 6 lowing:

1	"(H) Such country fails to cooperate fully
2	with the United States in preventing illegal
3	drug traffic and the entry of illegal drugs into
4	the United States."; and
5	(2) in the last sentence by striking "and (G)"
6	and inserting "(G), and (H)".
