A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to provide for public disclosure of the amounts of Federal funds used to conduct field examinations of appropriation estimates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF AMOUNTS USED FOR

FIELD EXAMINATIONS OF APPROPRIATION

ESTIMATES.

Section 1108(g) of title 31, United States Code, is

amended—

(1) by inserting "(1)" after "(g)"; and

1	(2) by adding at the end the following new
2	paragraph:
3	"(2) The head of each agency shall publish in the
4	Federal Register on a monthly basis notice containing the
5	following:
6	"(A) All amounts of the agency (if any) made
7	available during the previous month for field exami-
8	nations of appropriations estimates.
9	"(B) The purpose of each such field examina-
10	tion.
11	"(C) The location at which the field examina-
12	tion was conducted.
13	"(D) The identity of all Members of Congress,
14	congressional staff, and officers and employees of
15	the agency who participated in the field examina-
16	tion.".
