7 (1) by striking “and” at the end of clause (vii);

8 (2) by striking the period at the end of clause
9 (viii) and inserting “; and”; and

10 (3) by inserting after clause (viii) the following
11 new clause:

12 “(ix) develop and promote precision
13 agriculture and precision agriculture tech-
14 nologies.”.
