A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to repeal the provision allowing adjustment of status of unlawful aliens in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS OF UN-**
4 **LAWFUL ALIENS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (i) of section 245 of
6 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1255), as
7 added by section 605(b) of the Department of State and
8 Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 1995 (Public Law
9 103–317, 108 stat. 1765), is repealed.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The repeal made by sub-
2 section (a) shall apply to applications for adjustment of
3 status filed before, on, or after the date of the enactment
4 of this Act, except such applications as were approved as
5 of the date of the enactment of this Act. In the case of
6 such an application for adjustment filed, but not approved,
7 as of the date of the enactment of this Act, the Attorney
8 General shall promptly refund to the applicant the amount
9 of the application fee paid.
