Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 1361) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1996 for the Coast Guard, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1361) to authorize appropriations
- 6 for fiscal year 1996 for the Coast Guard, and for other
- 7 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed

with. Points of order against consideration of the bill for failure to comply with section 302(f), section 308(a), or section 401(b) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 3 4 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure. After general debate the bill shall be considered for 8 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-10 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure now printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered by title rather than by section. The first two sections and each title of the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. Points of order against the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute for failure to comply with clause 5(a) of rule XXI or section 302(f) or section 401(b)

25 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any

of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are waived. At

the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment

the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House

with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any

- 1 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the
- 2 bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a
- 3 substitute. The previous question shall be considered as
- 4 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-
