3 occurred at Oklahoma City, and making rescissions for the  
4 fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, and for other pur-  
5 poses. It shall be in order, any rule of the House to the  
6 contrary notwithstanding, to consider an amendment of-  
7 fered by the chairman of the Committee on Appropria-  
8 tions. That amendment (if offered) shall be considered as  
9 read and shall not be subject to a demand for division  
10 of the question. The previous question shall be considered  
11 as ordered on that amendment (if offered) and on the bill  
12 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one  
13 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
14 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
15 Appropriations; and (2) one motion to recommit with or  
16 without instructions.
