RESOLUTION

Amending clause 2 of rule XXII of the Rules of the House to prohibit the introduction or consideration of legislation designating a building or any other structure in honor of a person who is serving or has served as a Member of Congress, a Federal judge, or an officer of the executive branch before the date that is 5 years after the person has retired from that office.

1 *Resolved*, That clause 2 of rule XXII of the Rules
2 of the House of Representatives is amended by adding at
3 the end the following:

1 “(c) No bill or resolution, and no amendment to any
2 bill or resolution, designating a building or any other
3 structure in honor of a person who is serving or has served
4 as a Member of Congress, a Federal judge, or an officer
5 of the executive branch may be introduced or considered
6 in the House before the date that is 5 years after the per-
7 son has retired from that office.”.
