Mr. BRYANT of Texas submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2261) to provide for the regulation of lobbyists and gift reform, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-  
2       olution it shall be in order to consider in the House the  
3       bill (H.R. 2261) to provide for the regulation of lobbyists  
4       and gift reform, any rule of the House to the contrary  
5       notwithstanding. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-  
6       pensed with. Debate shall not exceed two hours, with one  
7       hour equally divided and controlled by the Chairman and  
8       ranking minority member of the Committee and ranking  
9       minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary and  
10      one hour equally divided and controlled by the Chairman

1 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Stand-  
2 ards of Official Conduct. The previous question shall be  
3 considered as ordered on the bill to final passage without  
4 intervening motion except one motion to recommit, with  
5 or without instructions.

6       SEC. 2. After passage of H.R. 2261, it shall be in  
7 order in the House, any rule of the House to the contrary  
8 notwithstanding, to take from the Speaker's table the bill  
9 (S. 1060), move to strike all after the enacting clause and  
10 insert in lieu thereof the provisions of title I of H.R. 2261  
11 as passed by the House. If the motion is adopted and the  
12 Senate bill, as amended, is passed, it shall then be in order  
13 to move that the House insist upon its amendment to S.  
14 1060 and request a conference with the Senate thereon.

15       SEC. 3. The amendment (relating to congressional  
16 gift rules) made by section 201 of H.R. 2261 to clause  
17 4 of rule XLIII of the Rules of the House of Representa-  
18 tives is hereby adopted. That amendment shall be effective  
19 for calendar years beginning on or after January 1, 1996.
