RESOLUTION

To limit the access of lobbyists to the Hall of the House.

1 *Resolved*, That clause 3 of rule XXXII of the Rules
2 of the House of Representatives is amended by adding at
3 the end the following: “Except as provided in this clause,
4 no individual who is a lobbyist registered under section
5 308 of the Federal Regulation of Lobbying Act may be
6 admitted to the Hall of the House.”.
