# RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 118) making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 1996, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this  
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any  
3 point of order consider in the House the joint resolution  
4 (H.J. Res. 118) making further continuing appropriations  
5 for the fiscal year 1996, and for other purposes. The joint  
6 resolution shall be debatable for one hour equally divided  
7 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
8 member of the Committee on Appropriations. It shall be  
9 in order, any rule of the House to the contrary notwith-

1 standing, to consider an amendment in the nature of a  
2 substitute to amend the date and make other appropriate  
3 changes, if offered by the minority leader or his designee.  
4 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
5 the joint resolution, as amended, to final passage without  
6 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with  
7 or without instructions.
