2 SECTION 1. FURTHER EXPENSES OF THE COMMITTEE ON 3 STANDARDS OF OFFICIAL CONDUCT.

4 For further expenses of the Committee on Standards 5 of Official Conduct (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the "committee"), there shall be paid out of the ap-6 7 plicable accounts of the House of Representatives not more than \$580,000, of which not more than \$400,0008 9 may be used for procurement of consultant services under 10 section 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 11 1946.

12 SEC. 2. VOUCHERS.

Payments under this resolution shall be made on
vouchers authorized by the committee, signed by the chairman of the committee, and approved in the manner directed by the Committee on House Oversight.

1 SEC. 3. LIMITATION.

Amounts shall be available under this resolution for
expenses incurred during the period beginning at noon on
January 3, 1996, and ending immediately before noon on
January 3, 1997.

6 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

7 Amounts made available under this resolution shall8 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by9 the Committee on House Oversight.

10 SEC. 5. ADJUSTMENT AUTHORITY.

11 The Committee on House Oversight shall have au-12 thority to make adjustments in amounts under section 1, 13 if necessary to comply with an order of the President is-14 sued under section 254 of the Balanced Budget and Emer-15 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 or to conform to any 16 reduction in appropriations for the purposes of such sec-17 tion 1.
