1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. FURTHER EXPENSES OF THE COMMITTEE ON**
3 **STANDARDS OF OFFICIAL CONDUCT.**

4 For further expenses of the Committee on Standards
5 of Official Conduct (hereinafter in this resolution referred
6 to as the “committee”), there shall be paid out of the ap-
7 plicable accounts of the House of Representatives not
8 more than \$580,000, of which not more than \$400,000
9 may be used for procurement of consultant services under
10 section 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of
11 1946.

12 **SEC. 2. VOUCHERS.**

13 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
14 vouchers authorized by the committee, signed by the chair-
15 man of the committee, and approved in the manner di-
16 rected by the Committee on House Oversight.

1 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION.**

2 Amounts shall be available under this resolution for
3 expenses incurred during the period beginning at noon on
4 January 3, 1996, and ending immediately before noon on
5 January 3, 1997.

6 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

7 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
8 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
9 the Committee on House Oversight.

10 **SEC. 5. ADJUSTMENT AUTHORITY.**

11 The Committee on House Oversight shall have au-
12 thority to make adjustments in amounts under section 1,
13 if necessary to comply with an order of the President is-
14 sued under section 254 of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
15 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 or to conform to any
16 reduction in appropriations for the purposes of such sec-
17 tion 1.
