- 1 be considered as ordered on the bill and any amendment
- 2 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:
- 3 (1) two hours of debate on the bill, equally divided and
- 4 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
- 5 of the Committee on National Security; (2) the amend-
- 6 ment in the nature of a substitute printed in the report
- 7 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution,
- 8 if offered by Representative Spratt of South Carolina or
- 9 his designee, which shall be in order without intervention
- 10 of any point of order, shall be considered as read, and
- 11 shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided
- 12 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3)
- 13 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
