IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

SEPTEMBER 27, 1996

Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of certain resolutions in preparation for the adjournment of the second session sine die.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House a joint resolu-
3 tion waiving certain enrollment requirements with respect
4 to any bill or joint resolution of the One Hundred Fourth
5 Congress making general or continuing appropriations for
6 fiscal year 1997. The joint resolution shall be debatable
7 for one hour equally divided and controlled by the majority
8 leader and the minority leader or their designees. The pre-

1 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the joint
2 resolution to final passage without intervening motion ex-
3 cept one motion to commit.

4 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
5 be in order to consider in the House a joint resolution
6 appointing the day for the convening of the first session
7 of the One Hundred Fifth Congress and the day for count-
8 ing in Congress of the electoral votes for President and
9 Vice President cast in December 1996. The joint resolu-
10 tion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and
11 controlled by the majority leader and the minority leader
12 or their designees. The previous question shall be consid-
13 ered as ordered on the joint resolution to final passage
14 without intervening motion except one motion to commit.

15 SEC. 3. A resolution providing that any organiza-
16 tional caucus or conference in the House of Representa-
17 tives for the One Hundred Fifth Congress may begin on
18 or after November 15, 1996, is hereby adopted.

19 SEC. 4. A resolution providing for the printing of a
20 revised edition of the Rules and Manual of the House of
21 Representatives for the One Hundred Fifth Congress as
22 a House document, and for the printing and binding of
23 three thousand additional copies for the use of the House,
24 of which nine hundred copies shall be bound in leather

1 with thumb index and delivered as may be directed by the
2 Parliamentarian of the House, is hereby adopted.

3 SEC. 5. Each committee of the House that is author-
4 ized to conduct investigations may file reports to the
5 House thereon following the adjournment of the second
6 session sine die.

7 SEC. 6. Reports on the activities of committees of the
8 House in the One Hundred Fourth Congress pursuant to
9 clause 1(d) of rule XI may be printed as reports of the
10 One Hundred Fourth Congress.

11 SEC. 7. The Speaker and the minority leader may ac-
12 cept resignations and make appointments to commissions,
13 boards, and committees following the adjournment of the
14 second session sine die as authorized by law or by the
15 House.

16 SEC. 8. The chairman and ranking minority member
17 of each standing committee and subcommittee may extend
18 their remarks in the Congressional Record and include a
19 summary of the work of their committee or subcommittee.

20 SEC. 9. All Members may extend their remarks in the
21 Congressional Record on any matter occurring prior to the
22 adjournment of the second session sine die.
