## RESOLUTION

Requiring that copies of the United States Code for any Member of the House of Representatives be paid for from the appropriate official allowance of the Member.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. UNITED STATES CODE FOR MEMBERS OF THE**  
3                       **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO BE PAID**  
4                       **FOR FROM OFFICIAL ALLOWANCES OF MEM-**  
5                       **BERS.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—The versions of the United States  
7       Code referred to in the provisions specified in subsection

1 (b) shall not be furnished under such provisions with re-  
2 spect to the House of Representatives. A Member of the  
3 House of Representatives may purchase any such version  
4 of the United States Code under the appropriate official  
5 allowance of the Member.

6 (b) PROVISIONS SPECIFIED.—The provisions referred  
7 to in subsection (a) are—

8 (1) section 212 of title 1, United States Code;  
9 and

10 (2) House Resolution 506, Ninetieth Congress,  
11 agreed to August 21, 1967, as enacted into perma-  
12 nent law by chapter VIII of title I of the second  
13 Supplemental Appropriation Act, 1968 (2 U.S.C.  
14 54).

15 **SEC. 2. REGULATIONS.**

16 The Committee on House Oversight shall have au-  
17 thority to prescribe regulations to carry out this resolu-  
18 tion.

19 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

20 Section 1 shall take effect at the beginning of the  
21 One Hundred Fifth Congress.
