Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 889) making emergency supplemental appropriations and rescissions to preserve and enhance the military readiness of the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 889) making emergency supple-

1 mental appropriations and rescissions to preserve and en-
2 hance the military readiness of the Department of Defense
3 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, and for
4 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
5 pensed with. General debate shall be confined to the bill
6 and the amendments made in order by this resolution and
7 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
8 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
9 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
10 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
11 minute rule and shall be considered as read. Points of
12 order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply
13 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. It shall be in order
14 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
15 ment under the five-minute rule an amendment in the na-
16 ture of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 889
17 modified as follows: on page 16, after line 12, insert a
18 new title V consisting of the text of the bill (H.R. 845)
19 rescinding certain budget authority, and for other pur-
20 poses. The amendment in the nature of a substitute shall
21 be considered as read. Points of order against that amend-
22 ment in the nature of a substitute for failure to comply
23 with clause 7 of rule XVI or clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI
24 are waived. No other amendment shall be in order except
25 the amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in

1 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
2 resolution, which may be offered only by Representative
3 Obey of Wisconsin or his designee, shall be considered as
4 read, shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and
5 controlled by the proponent and an opponent, and shall
6 not be subject to amendment. Points of order against the
7 amendment in the nature of a substitute for failure to
8 comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. At the con-
9 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment, the
10 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
11 such amendment as may have been adopted. Any Member
12 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-
13 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill
14 or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made
15 in order as original text. The previous question shall be
16 considered as ordered on the bill and any amendment
17 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
18 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
