A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of the C.S.S. Hunley to the State of South Carolina, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF C.S.S. HUNLEY TO THE STATE**

4 **OF SOUTH CAROLINA.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The President shall
6 direct the appropriate Federal official to convey to the
7 State of South Carolina, without consideration, all right,
8 title, and interest of the United States in and to the C.S.S.
9 Hunley, a sunken Confederate submarine located in a har-
10 bor in close proximity to Charleston, South Carolina.

1 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The official under
2 subsection (a) may require such terms and conditions in
3 connection with the conveyance under that subsection as
4 the official considers to be necessary to ensure the proper
5 preservation of the C.S.S. Hunley.
