A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to make a land exchange in the State of Montana, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.
4	In this Act:
5	(1) Church.—The term "Church" means the
6	Church Universal and Triumphant.
7	(2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
8	the Secretary of Agriculture.
9	(3) Specifications document.—The term
10	"specifications document" means the document enti-

1	tled "Church/Forest Service Land Exchange Speci-
2	fications" agreed to by the Church and the Sec-
3	retary under section 2(b)(3).
4	SEC. 2. LAND EXCHANGE.
5	(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other law, if
6	an offer is made under subsection (b), the Secretary shall
7	acquire by exchange certain lands and interests in land
8	owned by the Church, its successors and assigns, located
9	in the Yellowstone Controlled Groundwater Area and
10	Corwin Springs Known Geothermal Resource Area of the
11	Gallatin National Forest.
12	(b) Offer and Acceptance of Land and Inter-
13	ests in Land.—
14	(1) Non-federal lands and interests in
15	LAND.—If the Church offers—
16	(A) title that is acceptable to the United
17	States to all right, title, and interest to approxi-
18	mately 26 acres of land owned by the Church
19	as depicted on the maps entitled "Church/For-
20	est Services Land Exchange Proposal'', dated
21	July 1994;
22	(B) all right, title, and interest to the sub-
23	surface regulated resources estate on all Church
24	properties within the Yellowstone Controlled
25	Groundwater Area;

1	(C) a perpetual public access road and util-
2	ity easement 60 feet wide, plus allowance for
3	cuts and fills, over Church property to the Gal-
4	latin National Forest lands in the Cutler Home-
5	stead/Sentinel Butte area, as depicted on the
6	maps described in subparagraph (A); and
7	(D) other rights and covenants in accord-
8	ance with the terms of the specifications docu-
9	ment,
10	the Secretary shall accept a warranty deed to the
11	land described in subparagraph (A), a special war-
12	ranty deed to the regulated resources described in
13	subparagraph (B), State water rights transfer docu-
14	ments, and any other such instruments as are nec-
15	essary to transfer the property interests described in
16	subparagraphs (A), (B), (C), and (D).
17	(2) Federal land and interests in
18	LAND.—
19	(A) IN GENERAL.—On acceptance by the
20	Secretary of title to the lands, interests, and
21	rights and covenants offered by the Church
22	under paragraph (1)—
23	(i) the Secretary shall convey by pat-
24	ent to the Church, subject to all valid ex-
25	isting rights, and a reservation to the

1	United States of all regulated resources,
2	title to approximately 11 acres within the
3	Gallatin National Forest, as depicted on
4	the maps described in paragraph (1)(A);
5	(ii) the Secretary shall convey an
6	easement to the Church granting the right
7	to collect and transport across Federal
8	land the natural unenhanced surface flow
9	at LaDuke Hot Springs from its source to
10	the east bank of the Yellowstone River as
11	depicted on the maps described in para-
12	graph (1)(A), and the United States shall
13	withdraw all of its water rights claims and
14	objections filed with regard to LaDuke Hot
15	Springs in pending water rights adjudica-
16	tions under Federal and State law;
17	(iii) the Secretary shall grant to the
18	Church standard Forest Service right-of-
19	way authorizations for roads across Na-
20	tional Forest System land as generally de-
21	picted on the maps described in paragraph
22	(1)(A) and further defined by the specifica-
23	tions document; and
24	(iv) the Secretary shall grant to the
25	Church other rights and covenants in ac-

1 cordance with the terms of the specifica-2 tions document.

(B) SURVEYS.—Surveys prepared to standards approved by the Secretary shall be furnished by the Church for the affected Federal and non-Federal lands and surface interests prior to conveyance of the Federal lands and interests under subparagraph (A).

(3) Specifications document.—

- (A) IN GENERAL.—A document entitled "Church/Forest Service Land Exchange Specifications", jointly developed and agreed to by the Secretary and the Church shall define the non-Federal and Federal lands and interests to be exchanged under this Act, including legal descriptions of lands and interests in land and other terms, conditions, and covenants.
- (B) LIMITATION.—The specifications document shall not include any minimum surface flow requirements to the Yellowstone River from LaDuke Hot Springs.
- (C) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—The Secretary shall submit a copy of the completed specifications document to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate

and the Committee on Resources of the House 1 2 of Representatives, and the specifications document shall take effect 60 days thereafter. 3 (c) TITLE.— (1) Review of Title.—Within 90 days after receipt of the approved surveys and title documents 6 7 from the Church, the Secretary shall review the title 8 for the non-Federal lands described in subsection (b)(1) and determine whether— 9 (A) the applicable title standards for Fed-10 11 eral land acquisition have been satisfied; and 12 (B) all draft conveyances and closing documents have been received and approved. 13 14 (2) Corrective action.—If the quality of title 15 does not meet Federal standards or is otherwise un-16 acceptable to the Secretary, the Secretary shall ad-17 vise the Church regarding corrective actions nec-18 essary to cure title defects. (3) Conveyance of title.—The conveyance 19 20 to the Church of lands described in subsection (b)(2)(A) shall be completed not later than 90 days 21 22 after the Secretary approves title. SEC. 3. GENERAL PROVISIONS. 24 (a) Correction of Errors in Maps.—The maps described in section 2(b)(1)(i) are subject to correction of

- 1 any technical error in describing the lands and interests
- 2 in land to be exchanged under this Act.
- 3 (b) Availability for Public Inspection.—The
- 4 maps described in section 2(b)(1)(i) and the specifications
- 5 document shall be on file and available for public inspec-
- 6 tion in the Office of the Chief of the Forest Service, in
- 7 Washington, D.C.
- 8 (c) National Forest System Lands.—All lands
- 9 and interests in land conveyed to the United States under
- 10 this Act shall be administered in accordance with the laws
- 11 (including regulations) pertaining to the National Forest
- 12 System.
- 13 (c) VALUATION.—The value of the lands and inter-
- 14 ests in lands to be exchanged under this Act are deemed
- 15 to be equal, and no appraisal shall be required.

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
