Mr. COATS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To amend the United States Housing Act of 1937 to increase public housing opportunities for intact families.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Family Housing Act
5 of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC HOUSING FOR INTACT FAMILIES.**

7 Section 6(c)(4)(A) of the United States Housing Act
8 of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437d(c)(4)(A)) is amended—

9 (1) in clause (iii), by striking “and” at the end;

1 (2) in clause (iv), by striking the period at the
2 end and inserting “; and”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following new
4 clause:

5 “(v) for not less than 15 percent of
6 the units that are made available for occu-
7 pancy in a given fiscal year, give pref-
8 erence to any family that includes 2 indi-
9 viduals who are legally married to each
10 other;”.
