A BILL

To provide that Members of Congress shall not be paid during Federal Government shutdowns.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. PAY OF MEMBERS OF CONGRESS DURING GOV-
4	ERNMENT SHUTDOWNS.
5	No Member of Congress may receive basic pay for
6	any period in which—
7	(1) there is a lapse in appropriations for any
8	Federal agency or department as a result of a fail-
9	ure to enact a regular appropriations bill or continu-
0	ing resolution; or

- 1 (2) the Federal Government is unable to make 2 payments or meet obligations because the public 3 debt limit under section 3101 of title 31, United 4 States Code has been reached.
- 5 SEC. 2. RETROACTIVE PAY PROHIBITED.
- No pay forfeited in accordance with section 1 may be paid retroactively.
