**A BILL**

To amend the Congressional Award Act to revise and extend  
authorities for the Congressional Award Board.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Award  
5 Act Amendments of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF REQUIREMENTS REGARDING FINAN-**  
2 **CIAL OPERATIONS OF CONGRESSIONAL**  
3 **AWARD PROGRAM; NONCOMPLIANCE WITH**  
4 **REQUIREMENTS.**

5 Section 5(c)(2)(A) of the Congressional Award Act  
6 (2 U.S.C. 804(c)(2)(A)) is amended by striking “and  
7 1994” and inserting “1994, 1995, 1996, and 1997”.

8 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION.**

9 Section 9 of the Congressional Award Act (2 U.S.C.  
10 808) is amended by striking “October 1, 1995” and in-  
11 serting “October 1, 1998”.
