## A BILL

To improve the administration of the Women's Rights National Historical Park in the State of New York, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.**

4 The second sentence of section 1601(c) of Public Law  
5 ~~96-607 (16 U.S.C. 410*ll*)~~ is amended—

1           (1) by striking “initially”;

2           (2) by striking paragraph (7);

3           (3) by redesignating paragraphs (8) and (9) as  
4 paragraphs (7) and (8), respectively;

5           (4) in paragraph (7) (as redesignated), by strik-  
6 ing “and” at the end;

7           (5) in paragraph (8) (as redesignated), by strik-  
8 ing the period at the end and inserting a semicolon;  
9 and

10          (6) by adding at the end the following:

11           “~~(9)~~ not to exceed 1 acre, plus improvements,  
12 as determined by the Secretary, in Seneca Falls for  
13 development of a maintenance facility;

14           “~~(10)~~ dwelling, 1 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

15           “~~(11)~~ dwelling, 10 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

16           “~~(12)~~ parcels adjacent to Wesleyan Chapel  
17 Block, including Clinton Street, Fall Street, and  
18 Mynderse Street, Seneca Falls; and

19           “~~(13)~~ dwelling, 12 East Williams Street, Water-  
20 loo.”.

21 **SEC. 2. MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS.**

22          Section 1601 of Public Law 96-607 (16 U.S.C.  
23 410~~h~~) is amended—

24           (1) in subsection (h)(5), by striking “ten years”  
25 and inserting “25 years”; and

1           ~~(2)~~ in subsection (i)—

2                   (A) by inserting “(1)” after “(i)”;

3                   (B) by striking “\$700,000” and inserting  
4           “\$1,500,000”;

5                   (C) by striking “\$500,000” and inserting  
6           and “\$15,000,000”; and

7                   (D) by adding at the end the following:

8           ~~“(2) In addition to the sums appropriated before the~~  
9           ~~date of enactment of this paragraph for land acquisition~~  
10           ~~and development to carry out this section, there are au-~~  
11           ~~thorized to be appropriated for fiscal years beginning after~~  
12           ~~September 30, 1994, \$2,000,000.”.~~

13   **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF OTHER PROPERTIES.**

14           *Section 1601(c) of Public Law 96-607 (16 U.S.C.*  
15           *4101l) is amended to read as follows: “To carry out the pur-*  
16           *poses of this section there is hereby established the Women’s*  
17           *Rights National Historical Park (hereinafter in this section*  
18           *referred to as the ‘park’). The park shall consist of the fol-*  
19           *lowing designated sites in Seneca Falls and Waterloo, New*  
20           *York:*

21                   “(1) Stanton House, 32 Washington Street, Sen-  
22           eca Falls;

23                   “(2) dwelling, 30 Washington Street, Seneca  
24           Falls;

1           “(3) dwelling, 34 Washington Street, Seneca  
2 Falls;

3           “(4) lot, 26–28 Washington Street, Seneca Falls;

4           “(5) former Wesleyan Chapel, 126 Fall Street,  
5 Seneca Falls;

6           “(6) theater, 128 Fall Street, Seneca Falls;

7           “(7) McClintock House, 16 East Williams Street,  
8 Waterloo;

9           “(8) Hunt House, 401 East Williams Street,  
10 Waterloo;

11           “(9) not to exceed 1 acre, plus improvements, as  
12 determined by the Secretary, in Seneca Falls for de-  
13 velopment of a maintenance facility;

14           “(10) dwelling, 1 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

15           “(11) dwelling, 10 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

16           “(12) parcels adjacent to Wesleyan Chapel Block,  
17 including Clinton Street, Fall Street, and Mynderse  
18 Street, Seneca Falls; and

19           “(13) dwelling, 12 East Williams Street, Water-  
20 loo.”.

21 **SEC. 2. MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS.**

22           Section 1601 of Public Law 96–607 (16 U.S.C. 4101l)  
23 is amended by redesignating subsection (i) as “(i)(1)” and  
24 inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:

1       “(2) In addition to those sums appropriated prior to  
2 the date of enactment of this paragraph for land acquisition  
3 and development, there is hereby authorized to be appro-  
4 priated an additional \$2,000,000.”.
