3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal Triangle Project under construction at
5 14th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, Northwest, in the
6 District of Columbia, shall be known as the “Ronald
7 Reagan Building and International Trade Center”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade
6 Center”.
