3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Possessions and Terri-
- tories Criminal Law Clarification Act". 5

6 SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF VARIOUS OFFENSES TO POSSES-7

SIONS AND TERRITORIES.

(a) Sections 241 and 242 of title 18, United States 8 Code, are each amended by striking "any State, Territory, 9

or District'' and inserting ''any State, Territory, Common wealth, Possession, or District''.

3 (b) Sections 793(h)(1) and 794(d)(1) of title 18,
4 United States Code, are each amended by adding at the
5 end the following: "For the purposes of this subsection,
6 the term 'State' includes a State of the United States, the
7 District of Columbia, and any commonwealth, territory,
8 or possession of the United States.".

9 (c) Section 925(a)(5) of title 18, United States Code,
10 is amended by striking "For the purpose of paragraphs
11 (3) and (4)" and inserting "For the purpose of paragraph
12 (3)".

(d) Sections 1014 and 2113(g) of title 18, United
States Code, are each amended by adding at the end the
following: "The term 'State-chartered credit union' includes a credit union chartered under the laws of a State
of the United States, the District of Columbia, or any
commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United
States.".

(e) Section 1073 of title 18, United States Code, is
amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph the
following: "For the purposes of clause (3) of this paragraph, the term 'State' includes a State of the United
States, the District of Columbia, and any commonwealth,
territory, or possession of the United States.".

(f) Section 1715 of title 18, United States Code, is
 amended by striking "State, Territory, or District" each
 place those words appear and inserting "State, Territory,
 Commonwealth, Possession, or District".

5 (g) Section 1716 of title 18, United States Code, is 6 amended—

7 (1) in subsection (g)(2) by striking "State, Ter8 ritory, or the District of Columbia" and inserting
9 "State";

10 (2) in subsection (g)(3) by striking "the munici-11 pal government of the District of Columbia or of the 12 government of any State or territory, or any county, 13 city, or other political subdivision of a State" and in-14 serting "any State, or any political subdivision of a 15 State"; and

16 (3) by adding at the end the following:

"(j) For purposes of this section, the term 'State' includes a State of the United States, the District of Columbia, and any commonwealth, territory, or possession of the
United States.".

(h) Section 1761 of title 18, United States Code, isamended by adding at the end the following new sub-section:

"(d) For the purposes of this section, the term 'State' 1 means a State of the United States and any common-2 wealth, territory, or possession of the United States.". 3 (i) Section 3156(a) of title 18, United States Code, 4 5 is amended— (1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph 6 7 (3): (2) by striking the period and inserting "; and" 8 at the end of paragraph (4); and 9 (3) by adding at the end the following new 10 11 paragraph: "(5) the term 'State' includes a State of the 12 13 United States, the District of Columbia, and any 14 commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United 15 States.". (j) Section 102 of the Controlled Substances Act (21 16 U.S.C. 802) is amended— 17 18 (1) by amending paragraph (26) to read as fol-19 lows: "(26) The term 'State' means a State of the 20 United States, the District of Columbia, and any 21 22 commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United 23 States."; and (2) by redesignating paragraph (43), as added 24 by section 90105(d) of the Violent Crime Control 25

and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, as paragraph
 (44).

3 (k) Section 1121 of title 18, United States Code, is 4 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-5 section:

6 "(c) For the purposes of this section, the term 'State'
7 means a State of the United States, the District of Colum8 bia, and any commonwealth, territory, or possession of the
9 United States.".

(l) Section 228(d)(2) of title 18, United States Code,
is amended by inserting "commonwealth," before "possession or territory of the United States".

(m) Section 1546(c) of title 18, United States Code,
is amended by adding at the end the following: "For purposes of this section, the term 'State' means a State of
the United States, the District of Columbia, and any commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United States.".
(n) Section 1541 of title 18, United States Code, is

19 amended—

20 (1) in the first undesignated paragraph, by21 striking "or possession"; and

(2) by adding at the end the following newparagraph:

24 "For purposes of this section, the term 'State' means25 a State of the United States, the District of Columbia,

and any commonwealth, territory, or possession of the
 United States.".

3 (o) Section 37(c) of title 18, United States Code, is 4 amended in the final sentence by inserting before the pe-5 riod the following: '', and the term 'State' means a State 6 of the United States, the District of Columbia, and any 7 commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United 8 States''.

9 (p) Section 2281(c) of title 18, United States Code, 10 is amended in the final sentence by inserting before the 11 period the following: ", and the term 'State' means a State 12 of the United States, the District of Columbia, and any 13 commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United 14 States".

(q) Section 521(a) of title 18, United States Code,
is amended by adding at the end the following: "'State'
means a State of the United States, the District of Columbia, and any commonwealth, territory, or possession of the
United States.".
