A BILL

To designate a portion of the Red River in Louisiana as the “J. Bennett Johnston Waterway”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF J. BENNETT JOHNSTON WA-**
4 **TERWAY.**

5 The portion of the Red River, Louisiana, from new
6 river mile 0 to new river mile 235 shall be known and
7 designated as the “J. Bennett Johnston Waterway”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the portion
4 of the Red River described in section 1 shall be deemed
5 to be a reference to the “J. Bennett Johnston Waterway”.
