A BILL

To reduce Federal spending by restructuring the Air Force's F-22 program to achieve initial operating capability in 2010 and a total inventory of no more than 42 aircraft in 2015.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROGRAM RESTRUCTURE.**

4 (a) The Secretary of Defense shall defer the planned
5 initial operating capability of the F-22 until the year 2010
6 and adjust the schedule for research, development, testing,
7 evaluation and production accordingly. The Department

1 shall plan for a total inventory of no more than 42 F-
2 22 aircraft in the year 2015.

3 (b) Not later than 90 days after the date of enact-
4 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall submit
5 to Congress a report on the program developed under
6 paragraph (a). The report shall describe the proposed
7 scope, pace, and cost of the program.
