## A BILL

To strike the prohibition on the transmission of abortion-  
related matters, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Comstock Clean-up  
5 Act of 1996”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPORTATION OR TRANSPORTATION OF CERTAIN**  
7 **ABORTION-RELATED MATTERS.**

8 Section 1462 of title 18, United States Code, is  
9 amended by striking subsection (e).

1 **SEC. 3. MAILING OF ABORTION-RELATED MATTERS.**

2 Section 1461 of title 18, United States Code, is  
3 amended by striking “; and—” and all that follows  
4 through “Is declared” and inserting “is declared”.
