A BILL

To terminate the advanced light water reactor program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF ADVANCED LIGHT WATER
- 4 REACTOR PROGRAM.
- 5 (a) In General.—Subtitle C of title XXI of the En-
- 6 ergy Policy Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 13491 et seq.) is re-
- 7 pealed.
- 8 (b) Prohibition on Expenditure of Funds.—No
- 9 funds shall be expended for fiscal year 1997 in connection

- 1 with a program carried out under subtitle C of title XXI2 of the Energy Policy Act of 1992.
- 3 (c) Rescission of Funds.—There are rescinded—
- 4 (1) any amounts set aside or otherwise made 5 available, for programs carried out under subtitle C 6 of title XXI of the Energy Policy Act of 1992, that 7 are not expended as a result of this section; and
- 8 (2) the underlying appropriations for the 9 amounts described in paragraph (1).
- 10 (d) Use of Money for Service of the National
- 11 Debt.—It is the sense of Congress that any money re-
- 12 turned to the Treasury as a result of this section should
- 13 be deposited in the general fund of the Treasury to be
- 14 applied against expenses associated with servicing the na-
- 15 tional debt.
