A BILL

To extend the legislative authority for the Black Revolutionary War Patriots Foundation to establish a commemorative work.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY FOR**
4 **MEMORIAL ESTABLISHMENT.**

5 The legislative authority for the Black Revolutionary
6 War Patriots Foundation to establish a commemorative
7 work (as defined by the Commemorative Works Act (40
8 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.)) shall expire October 27, 1998, not-
9 withstanding the time period limitation specified in section

1 10(b) of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1010(b)) or in section 1 of
2 the Act entitled “An Act to amend the Commemorative
3 Works Act, and for other purposes”, approved August 26,
4 1994 (42 U.S.C. 1003 note).
