### A BILL

To clarify Federal law with respect to assisted suicide, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Assisted Suicide Fund-

5 ing Restriction Act of 1996".

## 6 SEC. 2. GENERAL PROHIBITION ON USE OF FEDERAL AS7 SISTANCE.

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds9 appropriated by the Congress shall be used to provide,

procure, furnish, fund, or support, or to compel any indi vidual, institution, or government entity to provide, pro cure, furnish, fund, or support, any item, good, benefit,
 program, or service, the purpose of which is to cause, or
 to assist in causing, the suicide, euthanasia, or mercy kill ing of any individual.

#### 7 SEC. 3. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.

8 Nothing in this Act, or in an amendment made by
9 this Act, shall be construed to create any limitation relat10 ing to—

(1) the withholding or withdrawing of medicaltreatment or medical care;

13 (2) the withholding or withdrawing of nutrition14 or hydration;

15 (3) abortion; or

(4) the use of an item, good, benefit, or service
furnished for the purpose of alleviating pain or discomfort, even if such use may increase the risk of
death, so long as such item, good, benefit, or service
is not also furnished for the purpose of causing, or
the purpose of assisting in causing, death, for any
reason.

None of the funds appropriated to the 11 District of Columbia pursuant to an authorization of ap-12 propriations under this title may be used to furnish any 13 item, or service, for the purpose of causing, or the purpose 14 of assisting in causing, the death of any individual, such 15 as by assisted suicide, euthanasia, or mercy killing.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act is amended by adding at the
end of the items relating to title V the following new item:
"Sec. 504. Ban on use of funds for assisted suicide and related services.".

(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
