A BILL

To prohibit extension or establishment of any national monument on public land without full compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act and the Endangered Species Act, and an express Act of Congress, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Public Lands Protec-
- 5 tion Act of 1996".

1 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON EXTENSION OR ESTABLISHMENT

- 2 **OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS.**
- The Act entitled "An Act for the preservation of
- 4 American antiquities", approved June 8, 1906 (16 U.S.C.
- 5 431 et seq.), is amended by adding at the end the follow-

- 8 OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS.
- 9 "Notwithstanding section 2, no extension or estab-
- 10 lishment of a national monument may be undertaken on
- 11 public land after the date of enactment of this section
- 12 without full compliance with the National Environmental
- 13 Policy Act and the Endangered Species Act, and an ex-
- 14 press Act of Congress.".
