1 SEC. 2. DAIRY VOTING REFORM.

2 Section 113(b) of the Dairy Production Stabilization 3 Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C. 4504(b)) is amended— 4 (1) by designating the first and second sen-5 tences as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively; 6 (2) by designating the third through fifth sen-7 tences as paragraph (3); 8 (3) by designating the sixth sentence as paragraph (4); 9 10 (4) by designating the seventh and eighth sen-11 tences as paragraph (5); 12 (5) by designating the ninth sentence as paragraph (6); 13 (6) in paragraph (1) (as so designated), by 14 striking "and appointment"; 15 16 (7) by striking paragraph (2) (as so designated) 17 and inserting the following new paragraph: 18 ((2)(A)(i)) Subject to clause (ii), members of the 19 Board shall be milk producers nominated in accordance 20 with subparagraph (B) and elected by a vote of producers through a process established by the Secretary. 21 22 "(ii) In carrying out clause (i), the Secretary shall 23 not permit an organization certified under section 114 to vote on behalf of the members of the organization. 24 25 "(B) Nominations shall be submitted by organiza-26 tions certified under section 114, or, if the Secretary de-

termines that a substantial number of milk producers are 1 2 not members of, or the interests of the producers are not represented by, a certified organization, from nominations 3 submitted by the producers in the manner authorized by 4 5 the Secretary. In submitting nominations, each certified organization shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the 6 7 Secretary that the milk producers who are members of the organization have been fully consulted in the nomination 8 process."; 9

designated), by striking "In making such appointments," and inserting "In establishing the process
for the election of members of the Board,"; and

(9) in paragraph (4) (as so designated)—
(A) by striking "appointment" and inserting "election"; and
(B) by striking "appointments" and insert-

ing "elections".

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
