Mr. SHELBY (for himself and Mr. HEFLIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make technical corrections to maps relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coastal Barrier Tech-
5 nical Corrections Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. COASTAL BARRIER RESOURCES SYSTEM.**

7 Section 4(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16
8 U.S.C. 3503(a)) is amended by inserting before the period

1 at the end the following: “and section 3 of the Coastal
2 Barrier Technical Corrections Act of 1995”.

3 **SEC. 3. CORRECTIONS TO MAPS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than the end of the 30-
5 day period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act,
6 the Secretary of the Interior shall make such corrections
7 to the maps described in subsection (b) as are necessary
8 to ensure that—

9 (1) depictions of areas on the maps are consist-
10 ent with the depictions of areas appearing on the
11 maps entitled _____, dated
12 _____, and on file with the Secretary;
13 and

14 (2) the Coastal Barrier Resources System es-
15 tablished by section 4 of the Coastal Barrier Re-
16 sources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503) does not include any
17 area that, on the day before the date of enactment
18 of this Act, was part of unit Q01 of the System.

19 (b) MAPS DESCRIBED.—The maps described in this
20 subsection are maps that—

21 (1) are included in the set of maps entitled
22 “Coastal Barrier Resources System”, dated October
23 24, 1990; and

24 (2) relate to the units of the Coastal Barrier
25 Resources System numbered—

1 (A) P04A, P05, P05A, P08, P10, P11A,
2 P18, P25, and FL-90; and

3 (B) Q01 (as in effect on the day before the
4 date of enactment of this Act).
