**A BILL**

To amend the National Parks and Recreation Act of 1978 to establish the Friends of Kaloko-Honokohau, an advisory commission for the Kaloko-Honokohau National Historical Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Na Hoa Pili Kaloko-  
3 Honokohau Re-establishment Act of 1995”.

4 **SEC. 2. RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY COMMISSION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section  
6 505(f)(7) of Public Law 95–625 (16 U.S.C. 396d(7)), the  
7 Na Hoa Pili O Kaloko-Honokohau, the Advisory Commis-  
8 sion for Kaloko-Honokohau National Historical Park, is  
9 re-established in accordance with section 505(f), as  
10 amended by subsection (b).

11 (b) TERMINATION DATE.—Section 505(f)(7) of Pub-  
12 lic Law 95–625 (16 U.S.C. 396d(7)) is amended by strik-  
13 ing “this Act” and inserting “the Na Hoa Pili Kaloko-  
14 Honokohau Re-establishment Act of 1995”.
