A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the minimum wage rate under such Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Working Wage In-
5 crease Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN THE MINIMUM WAGE RATE.**

7 Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of
8 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

1 “(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-
2 tion, not less than \$4.25 an hour during the period
3 ending July 3, 1995, not less than \$4.70 an hour
4 during the year beginning July 4, 1995, and not less
5 than \$5.15 an hour after July 3, 1996;”.
