## A BILL

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of a hydroelectric project in Kentucky, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
5 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16  
6 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-  
7 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 10228, the  
8 Commission may, at the request of the licensee for the  
9 project and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the  
10 good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements

1 of that section and the Commission's procedures under  
2 that section, extend the time period during which the li-  
3 censee is required to commence the construction of the  
4 project, under the extension described in subsection (b),  
5 for not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect  
7 on the date of the expiration of the extension of the period  
8 required for commencement of construction of the project  
9 described in subsection (a) that the Commission issued,  
10 prior to the date of enactment of this Act, under section  
11 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806).
