## **3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period 5 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 6 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-7 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 10228, the 8 Commission may, at the request of the licensee for the 9 project and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the 10 good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements of that section and the Commission's procedures under
that section, extend the time period during which the li censee is required to commence the construction of the
project, under the extension described in subsection (b),
for not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect 7 on the date of the expiration of the extension of the period 8 required for commencement of construction of the project 9 described in subsection (a) that the Commission issued, 10 prior to the date of enactment of this Act, under section 11 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806).
