Mr. FAIRCLOTH introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

To nullify an executive order that prohibits Federal contracts with companies that hire permanent replacements for striking employees, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. NULLIFICATION OF ORDER.**

4 Any executive order, or other rule or order, that—

5 (1) prohibits Federal contracts between the
6 United States and a contractor;

7 (2) requires the debarment of a contractor from
8 an award of a Federal contract; or

9 (3) imposes other sanction on a contractor,

1 on the basis that such contractor or organizational unit
2 thereof has permanently replaced lawfully striking employ-
3 ees of such contractor shall have no force or effect.
