# A BILL

To provide for the protection of wild horses within the Ozark National Scenic Riverways, Missouri, and prohibit the removal of such horses, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ozark Wild Horses
- 5 Protection Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF FREE-ROAMING HORSES.
- 7 The first section of the Act entitled "An Act to pro-
- 8 vide for the establishment of the Ozark National Scenic
- 9 Riverways in the State of Missouri, and for other pur-

- 1 poses", approved August 27, 1964 (16 U.S.C. 460m), is
- 2 amended in the first sentence by inserting "protection and
- 3 preservation of free-roaming horses," after "wildlife,".

#### 4 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION OF REMOVAL OF HORSES.

- 5 Section 5 of the Act entitled "An Act to provide for
- 6 the establishment of the Ozark National Scenic Riverways
- 7 in the State of Missouri, and for other purposes", ap-
- 8 proved August 27, 1964 (16 U.S.C. 460m-4), is amended
- 9 by adding at the end the following new subsection:
- 10 "(c) The Secretary may not remove, or allow or assist
- 11 in the removal of, any free-roaming horse from Federal
- 12 land within the boundaries of the Ozark National Scenic
- 13 Riverways, except in the case of a medical emergency or
- 14 natural disaster.".
