Mr. MURKOWSKI submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Correcting the enrollment of H.R. 402.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That the Clerk of the House of Representa-
3 tives is directed to correct the enrollment of H.R. 402 as
4 follows:

5 Amend section 109 to read:

6 **“SEC. 109. CONFIRMATION OF WOODY ISLAND AS ELIGI-**
7 **BLE NATIVE VILLAGE.**

8 “The Native Village of Woody, Island located on
9 Woody Island, Alaska, in the Koniag Region, is hereby
10 confirmed as an eligible Alaska Native Village, pursuant
11 to section 11(b)(3) of the Alaska Native Claims Settle-
12 ment Act (“ANCSA”). It is further confirmed that

1 Leisnoi, Inc., is the Village Corporation, as that term is
2 defined in section 3(j) of ANCSA, for the village of Woody
3 Island. This section shall become effective on October 1,
4 1998, unless the United States judicial system determines
5 this village was fraudulently established under ANCSA
6 prior to October 1, 1998.”.
