"The Native Village of Woody, Island located on 8 Woody Island, Alaska, in the Koniag Region, is hereby 9 confirmed as an eligible Alaska Native Village, pursuant 10 to section 11(b)(3) of the Alaska Native Claims Settle-11 ment Act ("ANCSA"). It is further confirmed that 12 Leisnoi, Inc., is the Village Corporation, as that term is 13 defined in section 3(j) of ANCSA, for the village of Woody 14 Island. This section shall become effective on October 1. 15 1998, unless the United States judicial system determines 16

2 prior to October 1, 1998.".
