### **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

To authorize the printing of "Vice Presidents of the United States, 1789–1993".

- Whereas the United States Constitution provides that the Vice President of the United States shall serve as President of the Senate; and
- Whereas the careers of the 44 Americans who held that post during the years 1789 through 1993 richly illustrate the development of the nation and its government; and
- Whereas the vice presidency, traditionally the least understood and most often ignored constitutional office in the

Federal Government, deserves wider attention: Now, therefore, be it

- 3 SECTION 1. PRINTING OF THE "VICE PRESIDENTS OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, 1789–1993".
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—There shall be printed as a Senate
- 6 document the book entitled "Vice Presidents of the United
- 7 States, 1789–1993", prepared by the Senate Historical
- 8 Office under the supervision of the Secretary of the Sen-
- 9 ate.
- 10 (b) Specifications.—The Senate document de-
- 11 scribed in subsection (a) shall include illustrations and
- 12 shall be in the style, form, manner, and binding as di-
- 13 rected by the Joint Committee on Printing after consulta-
- 14 tion with the Secretary of the Senate.
- 15 (c) Number of Copies.—In addition to the usual
- 16 number of copies, there shall be printed with suitable bind-
- 17 ing the lesser of—
- 18 (1) 1,000 copies (750 paper bound and 250
- 19 case bound) for the use of the Senate, to be allo-
- 20 cated as determined by the Secretary of the Senate;
