

1 States within seven years after the date of final passage
2 of this joint resolution:

3 “ARTICLE—

4 “SECTION. 1. Congress shall have power to set rea-
5 sonable limits on expenditures made in support of or in
6 opposition to the nomination or election of any person to
7 Federal office.

8 “SECTION. 2. Each State shall have power to set rea-
9 sonable limits on expenditures made in support of or in
10 opposition to the nomination or election of any person to
11 State office.

12 “SECTION. 3. Each local government of general juris-
13 diction shall have power to set reasonable limits on ex-
14 penditures made in support of or in opposition to the nom-
15 ination or election of any person to office in that govern-
16 ment. No State shall have power to limit the power estab-
17 lished by this section.

18 “SECTION. 4. Congress shall have power to imple-
19 ment and enforce this article by appropriate legislation.”.
