## RESOLUTION

To authorize representation by Senate Legal Counsel.

Whereas, in the case of Charles Okoren, et al. v. Fyfe Symington, et al., No. CV-95-2527-PHX-RCB, pending in the United States District Court for the District of Arizona, the plaintiffs have named the United States Senate as a defendant;

Whereas pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (2 U.S.C. sections 288b(a) and 288c(a)(1) (1994)), the Senate may direct its counsel to defend the Senate in civil actions relating to its official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it
