RESOLUTION

To express the sense of the Senate that livestock producers who are not eligible for emergency livestock feed assistance in the 1996 crop year, and who have suffered feed losses due to drought, flooding, or other natural disasters in 1996, should receive special consideration for assistance from commodities or the sale of commodities currently available in the disaster reserve established under section 813 of the Agricultural Act of 1970, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL CONSIDERATION FOR DISASTER AS-**
2 **SISTANCE.**

3 It is the sense of the Senate that livestock producers
4 who do not qualify for emergency livestock feed assistance
5 for the 1996 crop year, but have incurred feed losses in
6 1996 due to drought, flooding, or other natural disasters,
7 should receive special consideration for assistance from
8 commodities or the sale of commodities currently available
9 in the disaster reserve established under section 813 of
10 the Agricultural Act of 1970 (7 U.S.C. 1427a). A livestock
11 producer should be eligible to receive the assistance during
12 the period beginning May 1, 1996, and ending not sooner
13 than August 31, 1996.
