Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 93]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 93, by a record vote of 8 to 4, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for the consideration of H.R. 450, the "Regulatory Transition Act of 1995" under a modified open rule. The rule provides one hour of general debate divided equally between the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Government Reform and Oversight.

The rule makes in order the Government Reform and Oversight Committee amendment in the nature of a substitute as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not to exceed 10 hours.

The substitute is considered as read, meaning it is open to amendment at any point. The Chair may accord priority in recognition to Members who have pre-printed their amendments in the Record, and such amendments are considered as read.

Finally, the rule provides for one motion to recommit, with or without instructions.
