## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress that a postage stamp should be issued to raise public awareness of diabetes and to promote public support for diabetes research.

- 1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of the Congress that—  
3            (1) a postage stamp should be issued to raise  
4            public awareness of diabetes and to promote public  
5            support for diabetes research; and

1           (2) the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee  
2           should recommend to the Postmaster General that  
3           such a stamp be issued.
