## A BILL

To require the continued availability of \$1 Federal reserve notes for circulation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Save the Greenback  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO MAINTAIN MINIMUM AMOUNTS**  
7 **OF \$1 FEDERAL RESERVE NOTES IN CIRCULA-**  
8 **TION.**

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-  
10 retary of the Treasury and the Board of Governors of the

1 Federal Reserve System shall take such action as may be  
2 necessary to ensure that the number of Federal reserve  
3 notes in the denomination of \$1 which are in circulation  
4 at any time does not decrease below the number of such  
5 reserve notes in circulation as of the date of the enactment  
6 of this Act.
